Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Financial Report

Chief Barkell stated that there is a balance of \$25,537.00 in the DUI Task Force budget.

MIP and DUI Reports

Chief Tim Barkell reported that there are a total of 33 DUIs and 39 MIPs to-date for 2015. The monthly totals are as follows:

January -	1 DUI and 4 MIPs
February -	4 DUIs and 3 MIPs
March -	8 DUIs and 9 MIPs
April -	2 DUIs and 3 MIPs
May -	0 DUIs and 10 MIPs (7 MIPs were from a house party on Alder)
June -	3 DUIs and 0 MIPs
July -	8 DUIs and 8 MIPs
August -	2 DUIs and 2 MIPs
September -	4 DUIs and 0 MIPs
October -	1 DUI and 0 MIPs to-date

Heidi Nielsen commented that it was refreshing to see two consecutive months without MIP activity so far, but added that rumor has it that AHS students are having fires (bonfires with drinking) every weekend. Marti Spotted Eagle said that she heard these fires are taking place out on Cable Creek and out toward Georgetown Lake. Keith Lopez noted that football season being in full effect may have something to do with fewer MIPs right now.

Upcoming Events

The DUI Task Force discussed how pleased they all were with the *Coffee With A Cop* event that was held on September 17th at the Coffee Corral. They noted that the patrons were very pleasant with the topics of conversation and the officers enjoyed the experience enough that the group agrees it would behoove the DUI Task Force to repeat the event. The task force was flexible with mixing up the venue to share the host site with a variety of local businesses.

Marti Spotted Eagle mentioned an upcoming Alive After 5 fundraiser in November. Apart from that, there are no extraordinary upcoming events historically involving drinking and driving between now and the next DUI Task Force meeting.

Public Comment


There was no public comment.
